Chemicals and Petrochemicals Expo (CPX) 2025

The Chemicals & Petrochemicals Expo 2025 (CPX 2025), which had been organised by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), was held from 12 to 14 November 2025 at the Mahatma Mandir Convention & Exhibition Centre in Gandhinagar, Gujarat. 
